A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of districts for the election of
- 3 members of the United States House of Representatives from Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The redistricting plan identified as PLANC241 on
- 6 the redistricting computer system operated by the Texas Legislative
- 7 Council is adopted as the permanent plan for districts used to elect
- 8 members of the United States House of Representatives from the
- 9 State of Texas.
- 10 SECTION 2. (a) This Act supersedes all previous enactments
- 11 or orders adopting congressional districts for the State of Texas.
- 12 (b) Chapter 1 (S.B. 4), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, 1st
- 13 Called Session, 2011 (Article 197j, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes),
- 14 is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 3. The districts included in the redistricting plan
- 16 adopted under Section 1 of this Act apply to the election of the
- 17 members of the United States House of Representatives from Texas
- 18 beginning with the primary and general elections in 2014 for
- 19 members of the 114th Congress. This Act does not affect the
- 20 membership or congressional districts of the 113th Congress.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

- 1 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 2 legislative session.
