11 WHEREAS, Ken Bailey transformed more than 200 acres of bare 12 land into a thriving site with a growing forest and habitat for fish and wildlife; the owner of Lifecheck Drug pharmacy, he had no 13 previous forestry experience, but with the assistance of agency 14 personnel, he has created a garden and an orchard, as well as ponds; 15 16 he has also installed brush piles for rabbits, bee hives, bat houses, and more than 50 bluebird houses; the wonderful array of 17 wildflowers on the property includes bluebonnets, honeysuckle, 18 morning glories, and sunflowers; and 19
