

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Corporal Harold Eugene Haywood is retiring from the
2 Eules Police Department in 2013, drawing to a close an exemplary
3 tenure in law enforcement that has spanned nearly four decades; and

4 WHEREAS, Gene Haywood began his career in California, where
5 he was a sergeant in the police reserves of the Winters Police
6 Department and a firefighter in Granite Bay; he also served in the
7 California National Guard for six years; after moving to Texas, he
8 was employed for a time as a security guard for The University of
9 Texas Health Science Center; and

10 WHEREAS, Joining the Eules Police Department in 1981,
11 Mr. Haywood was first hired as a jailer; he went on to work in the
12 Criminal Investigation Division and in the Patrol Division, and he
13 also served on the Tarrant County Auto Theft Task Force; over the
14 years, Mr. Haywood helped establish and manage the department's
15 Field Training Program, and he played an instrumental role in the
16 creation of the Eules Honor Guard; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Haywood was promoted to corporal in 1993, and
18 since 2001, he has served as the school resource officer at Keys
19 Learning Center; certified as an instructor and as a master police
20 officer, he has received numerous commendations and he has twice
21 been nominated for officer of the year; in addition, he has served
22 on the board of the Eules Peace Officers Association, which helps
23 raise money for worthy causes; and

24 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Haywood has enjoyed the

1 love and support of his wife, Betty, and their two daughters; and

2 WHEREAS, Gene Haywood's dedication, professionalism, and
3 commitment to preserving the safety and welfare of the public have
4 greatly benefited the citizens of Euless, and he may indeed reflect
5 with pride on a career well spent as he embarks on the next exciting
6 chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
8 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate Corporal
9 Harold Eugene Haywood on his retirement from the Euless Police
10 Department and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued
11 happiness; and, be it further

13 prepared for Corporal Haywood as an expression of high regard by the
14 Texas House of Representatives.
