- 3 14, 2013, at the age of 95; and
- WHEREAS, Lee Clardy was born in Zephyr, Texas, on December 9,
- 5 1917, to Ernest and Beulah Clardy, and he grew up in nearby
- 6 Brownwood, where he was admired for his leadership abilities and
- 7 his skill at sports and singing; after attending John Tarleton
- 8 College, he earned his bachelor's degree at The University of Texas
- 9 and subsequently returned to Tarleton to take a position as dean of
- 10 men; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mr. Clardy answered his nation's call to duty during
- 12 World War II and joined the U.S. Navy; serving as a gunnery officer
- 13 on the USS Arkansas, he saw action in three of the most important
- 14 invasions of the war, in Normandy and on the islands of Okinawa and
- 15 Iwo Jima; and
- WHEREAS, Following his military service, Mr. Clardy embarked
- 17 on a career in human resources with his employment by the P. H.
- 18 Glatfelter Company in Spring Grove, Pennsylvania; returning to
- 19 Texas, he went to work for the Champion Paper Company in Houston
- 20 until he was transferred to Dunwoody, Georgia, a suburb of Atlanta,
- 21 in 1970; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Mr. Clardy was active in his community and was a
- 23 valued member of the Dunwoody United Methodist Church and the Rose
- 24 Society; he remained proud of his service to his country, and he

- 1 often dressed in his Navy uniform to share his experiences at school
- 2 assemblies; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Clardy enjoyed the love
- 4 and support of his wife, the former Julia Barnes from Brownwood,
- 5 with whom he shared 64 rewarding years; he also took great pride in
- 6 their children, Alan and Janet; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Devoted to his family and his faith, Lee Clardy was
- 8 an optimistic and outgoing man who delighted in sharing his robust
- 9 sense of humor, and the generosity with which he lived his life will
- 10 forever inspire all who had the good fortune to know him; now,
