1 WHEREAS, The baseball team from Carlisle High School in Price
2 reached the pinnacle of success by winning the 2013 University
3 Interscholastic League 1A state championship on June 6 at Dell
4 Diamond in Round Rock; and

5 WHEREAS, Playing inspired baseball from start to finish in
6 2013, the Indians lost just one game in the regular season on their
7 way to claiming the District 20-1A title; in the playoffs, the team
8 reeled off victories over McLeod, Bowie, West Sabine, and Douglass
9 High Schools to earn their place in the state tournament, and a win
10 in the semifinals against Weimar allowed Carlisle to advance to the
11 title contest against Stamford; and

12 WHEREAS, Taking the mound with the state crown on the line,
13 Zach Brightwell allowed only three hits and struck out seven in
14 delivering a complete game to garner the most valuable player
15 honor; Carlisle broke the game open with four runs in the fifth
16 inning and went on to win 6-1, as Caleb Colley, Kolton Heim, Jaylan
17 Holland, and Ty Baker each had multiple hits during the game; and

18 WHEREAS, Excelling through a true team effort, the Indians
19 also benefited from the valuable contributions made throughout the
20 season by the other members of the roster: Kyle Byrd, Clay Allphin,
21 Ben Goss, Shadow Sanders, Dylan Sanders, Cooper Grigsby, Michael
22 Savala, Gunner Baker, Collin Gray, Justin McMurtry, and Dalton
23 Sanders; the players were guided by head coach Wesley Colley and
24 assistant coaches Rocky Baker and Cal Goss; and

1 WHEREAS, In capturing the first state baseball championship
2 in school history, the talented student-athletes of the Carlisle
3 Indians baseball team demonstrated remarkable determination and an
4 unwavering commitment to excellence, and they are a source of
5 tremendous pride to their school and to their many supporters in the
6 local community; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
8 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate the Carlisle
9 High School baseball team on winning the 2013 UIL 1A state
