R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Mike Falick retired as vice president of the Spring  
2 Branch Independent School District Board of Trustees in May 2013,  
3 drawing to a close a notable tenure with the board that spanned  
4 nearly a decade; and

5           WHEREAS, Since joining the board in 2004, Mr. Falick served  
6 two terms each as president and vice president, and he was the  
7 legislative liaison for his entire nine years; moreover, he has  
8 contributed his expertise as liaison for facilities, curriculum,  
9 technology, administration, and community relations; and

10           WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan was instrumental in a number of  
11 initiatives to improve the quality of education for all students,  
12 including changes to homework policies, state-administered  
13 testing, and class rank; he also advocated for Spring Branch to  
14 become the top district for college readiness in Texas, now a  
15 central pillar of its five-year plan; in addition, he was president  
16 during the largest successful bond election in the district's  
17 history, which passed with 60 percent of the vote and has  
18 facilitated extensive rebuilding and renovation efforts; and

19           WHEREAS, Through his skill, professionalism, and vision,  
20 Mike Falick greatly benefited Spring Branch ISD, and his devotion  
21 to the cause of public education has earned him the admiration and  
22 gratitude of his fellow citizens; now, therefore, be it
