- 1 WHEREAS, The annual Dallas County free summer meals program
- 2 is being launched with a kickoff event on June 21, 2013; and
- 3 WHEREAS, More than one in four Texas children struggle with
- 4 hunger, including over 165,000 children in Dallas County alone; as
- 5 many families rely on school lunch and breakfast programs, the
- 6 summer months may be a time of anxiety and uncertainty because of
- 7 the strain they place on already tight food budgets; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Agriculture established the
- 9 Summer Food Service Program to ensure that low-income youth have
- 10 access to nutritious meals even while school is out of session; in
- 11 the summer of 2012, approximately 36,000 young people received a
- 12 meal each day from one of the nearly 1,700 designated sites across
- 13 Dallas County; many of these summer meal sites additionally provide
- 14 fun learning and recreational activities, allowing children and
- 15 teens to enjoy a free, healthy meal while staying active and
- 16 spending time with friends; and
- WHEREAS, An adequate, balanced diet is crucial to a child's
- 18 physical and emotional development and can thus profoundly impact
- 19 his or her well-being in later life; by addressing a need of
- 20 critical importance, the summer meals initiative is providing an
- 21 essential service to many area Texans, and it is a privilege to join
- 22 in marking the commencement of the 2013 program; now, therefore, be
