RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The annual Dallas County free summer meals program
is being launched with a kickoff event on June 21, 2013; and

3 WHEREAS, More than one in four Texas children struggle with 4 hunger, including over 165,000 children in Dallas County alone; as 5 many families rely on school lunch and breakfast programs, the 6 summer months may be a time of anxiety and uncertainty because of 7 the strain they place on already tight food budgets; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Agriculture established the 8 9 Summer Food Service Program to ensure that low-income youth have access to nutritious meals even while school is out of session; in 10 11 the summer of 2012, approximately 36,000 young people received a meal each day from one of the nearly 1,700 designated sites across 12 Dallas County; many of these summer meal sites additionally provide 13 14 fun learning and recreational activities, allowing children and teens to enjoy a free, healthy meal while staying active and 15 spending time with friends; and 16

WHEREAS, An adequate, balanced diet is crucial to a child's physical and emotional development and can thus profoundly impact his or her well-being in later life; by addressing a need of critical importance, the summer meals initiative is providing an essential service to many area Texans, and it is a privilege to join in marking the commencement of the 2013 program; now, therefore, be it
