2 the math section of the SAT, and this rare feat is indeed deserving  
3 of recognition; and

4           WHEREAS, A student at Hornedo Middle School, Andrew is just  
5 12 years old, and he took the SAT as part of the application process  
6 for the Johns Hopkins Center for Talented Youth, an international  
7 program that identifies gifted young people; of the 10,000 students  
8 who applied to the center this year, he was one of only nine to earn  
9 a perfect score on the math section; he will be honored by the  
10 center for his achievement in August 2013; and

11           WHEREAS, Andrew Barnett is a member of the math team at his  
12 middle school and has won more than 30 medals and trophies in math  
13 competitions; he also enjoys reading, fencing, and tae kwon do, a  
14 sport in which he has earned a black belt; and

15           WHEREAS, This remarkable youth has demonstrated initiative  
16 and maturity in pursuing his goals, and he is a source of great  
17 pride to his family and his community; now, therefore, be it

19 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate Andrew  
20 Barnett on attaining a perfect score on the math portion of the SAT  
21 and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be
