R E S O L U T I O N

2 mourning the untimely passing of Stanley Allen Wilson of Dallas
3 Fire-Rescue, who died in the line of duty on May 20, 2013, at the age
4 of 51; and

5 WHEREAS, Stan Wilson was born in Dallas on August 18, 1961, to
6 Jess and Nell Pressly Wilson; after graduating from Lake Highlands
7 High School in 1979, he went on to earn a bachelor's degree in
8 business administration from The University of Texas at Austin in
9 1984; and

10 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan joined Dallas Fire-Rescue in
11 1985 and served with courage and distinction for 28 years,
12 achieving certification as a master firefighter; he spent two
13 decades with the crew at Station 53, where he was second driver; and

14 WHEREAS, Stan Wilson married Jenny Reeves in 1992, and the
15 couple became the proud parents of two sons, Noah and Luke;
16 Mr. Wilson put his family at the center of his life, and he took
17 deep satisfaction in his roles as husband and father; he served as
18 quartermaster of his sons' Boy Scout troop, and he was also active,
19 together with his family, in Park Cities Baptist Church; and

20 WHEREAS, Stan Wilson lived a rich and purposeful life,
21 dedicating himself without reserve to his family, his faith, and
22 his community, and his unflinching example of valor and selflessness
23 will continue to inspire all who were blessed to know him; now,
24 therefore, be it
