WHEREAS, Mr. Haugen spent the earlier part of his career in 15 the Gadsden ISD in New Mexico and in the Canutillo ISD; after 16 graduating from college in 1975, he joined the Gadsden district as a 17 social studies teacher and a track and football coach; he went on to 18 serve as athletic director and as assistant principal at Gadsden 19 20 High School, then as a middle school principal and an elementary school assistant principal in Canutillo; he returned to the Gadsden 21 district to become a high school principal, and he subsequently 22 23 served as superintendent of the Gadsden ISD from 2001 to 2007; and

- 6 Services, and the New Mexico Activities Association; in recognition
- 7 of the outstanding skill with which he carried out his
- 8 responsibilities, he was nominated for the 2006 New Mexico
- 9 Superintendent of the Year award; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Through his exemplary leadership and unwavering
- 11 commitment to the highest educational standards, Ronald Haugen has
- 12 contributed immeasurably to advancing the missions of the districts
- 13 in which he has worked, and he has helped countless area
- 14 schoolchildren to acquire a strong academic foundation; now,
