## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to fund
- 3 capital projects for the Texas Tech University Health Sciences
- 4 Center at El Paso.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 55.1789 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 55.1789. TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL
- 9 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this
- 10 subchapter, the board of regents of the Texas Tech University
- 11 System may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate,
- 12 enlarge, or equip property and facilities, including roads and
- 13 related infrastructure, for projects for the Texas Tech University
- 14 Health Sciences Center at El Paso, to be financed through the
- 15 issuance of bonds in accordance with this subchapter and in
- 16 accordance with a systemwide revenue financing program adopted by
- 17 the board, not to exceed the following aggregate principal amounts
- 18 for the projects specified as follows:
- 19 (1) \$89.1 million for the El Paso Medical Science
- 20 Building II; and
- 21 (2) \$27 million for the El Paso Clinical Sciences
- 22 Building.
- 23 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of the
- 24 bonds authorized by this section all or any part of the revenue

- 1 funds of an institution, branch, or entity of the Texas Tech
- 2 University System, including student tuition charges. The amount
- 3 of a pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or
- 4 abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds
- 5 issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.
- 6 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to
- 7 meet its obligations under this section, the board may transfer
- 8 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of the Texas Tech
- 9 University System to ensure the most equitable and efficient
- 10 allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or
- 11 entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 12 (d) Any portion of the proceeds of bonds authorized by this
- 13 section that is not required for the specific project for which the
- 14 bonds are authorized may be used to renovate existing structures
- 15 and facilities of the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center
- 16 <u>at El Paso.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) If S.B. No. 215, Acts of the 83rd
- 18 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, does not become law, Subsection
- 19 (e), Section 61.0572, Education Code, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- (e) Approval of the board is not required to acquire real
- 22 property that is financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)
- 23 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.1735(a)(1), 55.174,
- 24 55.1742, 55.1743, 55.1744, 55.1751-55.17592, 55.1768, 55.1771,
- 25 [or] 55.17721, or 55.1789, except that the board shall review all
- 26 real property to be financed by bonds issued under those sections to
- 27 determine whether the property meets the standards adopted by the

- 1 board for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the property does not
- 2 meet those standards, the board shall notify the governor, the
- 3 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 4 and the Legislative Budget Board.
- 5 (b) If S.B. No. 215, Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular
- 6 Session, 2013, becomes law, this section has no effect.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) If S.B. No. 215, Acts of the 83rd
- 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, does not become law, Subsection
- 9 (b), Section 61.058, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (b) This section does not apply to construction, repair, or
- 11 rehabilitation financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)
- 12 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.174, 55.1742,
- 13 55.1743, 55.1744, 55.1751-55.17592, 55.1768, 55.1771, [ex]
- 14 55.17721, or 55.1789, except that the board shall review all
- 15 construction, repair, or rehabilitation to be financed by bonds
- 16 issued under those sections to determine whether the construction,
- 17 rehabilitation, or repair meets the standards adopted by board rule
- 18 for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the construction,
- 19 rehabilitation, or repair does not meet those standards, the board
- 20 shall notify the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of
- 21 the house of representatives, and the Legislative Budget Board.
- 22 (b) If S.B. No. 215, Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular
- 23 Session, 2013, becomes law, this section has no effect.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
