- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 65(b), Article XVI, Texas Constitution,
- 8 is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) If any of the officers named herein shall announce their
- 10 candidacy, or shall in fact become a candidate, in any General,
- 11 Special or Primary Election, for any office of profit or trust under
- 12 the laws of this State or the United States other than the office
- 13 then held, at any time when the unexpired term of the office then
- 14 held shall exceed one year and 60 [30] days, such announcement or
- 15 such candidacy shall constitute an automatic resignation of the
- 16 office then held, and the vacancy thereby created shall be filled
- 17 pursuant to law in the same manner as other vacancies for such
- 18 office are filled.
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to change the length of
- 23 the unexpired term that causes the automatic resignation of certain
- 24 elected county or district officeholders if they become candidates
