RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 83rd Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby commend the publisher, editors, and staff of the San Marcos Daily Record for their exemplary work in carrying on the newspaper's legacy of community service and extend best wishes for continued success; and, be it further
