## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to an interim study on the Evins Regional Juvenile Center
- 3 in Edinburg.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The executive director of the Texas Juvenile
- 6 Justice Department shall create a committee composed of employees
- 7 of the department to conduct an interim study on the conditions at
- 8 and operation of the Evins Regional Juvenile Center in Edinburg.
- 9 (b) The committee shall prepare a report that includes:
- 10 (1) a summary of the incidents of violence, abuse,
- 11 neglect, exploitation, or other misconduct or criminal activity
- 12 occurring or alleged to have occurred at the facility in the
- 13 preceding 10 years;
- 14 (2) the response of the facility to the incidents or
- 15 allegations of violence, abuse, neglect, exploitation, or other
- 16 misconduct or criminal activity, including steps taken by the
- 17 facility to:
- 18 (A) implement the remedial measures prescribed
- 19 by the Civil Rights Division of the United States Department of
- 20 Justice in March 2007;
- 21 (B) investigate the events leading to the arrest
- 22 of officers in June 2013 and, as necessary, implement measures to
- 23 prevent future similar incidents; and
- (C) enforce other facility and Texas Juvenile

- 1 Justice Department policies to prevent and address violence, abuse,
- 2 neglect, exploitation, or other misconduct or criminal activity in
- 3 the facility; and
- 4 (3) recommendations for improving conditions at the
- 5 facility.
- 6 (c) The committee shall submit the report under this section
- 7 to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 8 representatives, and appropriate standing committees of the
- 9 legislature not later than December 1, 2014.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act expires June 1, 2015.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 16 legislative session.
