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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 531.095 to read as follows:
- Sec. 531.095. UNINTENDED PREGNANCIES AND SEXUALLY 8
- 9 TRANSMITTED DISEASES: OUTREACH CAMPAIGN AND SERVICES PROVIDED. (a)
- To the extent money is available for the purposes provided by this 10
- section, the commission shall provide adequate and sufficient 11
- funding to conduct a comprehensive marketing and outreach campaign 12
- to reduce the number of unintended pregnancies and lower the rates 13
- of sexually transmitted diseases. The campaign must include print 14
- and broadcast media, Internet websites, and a toll-free telephone 15
- 16 number.
- (b) The commission, the Legislative Budget Board, or the 17
- governor, in providing adequate and sufficient funding for the 18
- campaign as required by Subsection (a), may not take any action to 19
- decrease the level of programs and services designed to reduce the 20
- number of unintended pregnancies and lower the rates of sexually 21
- transmitted diseases to below the level of programs and services 22
- 23 provided on September 1, 2013.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 5 legislative session.
