1	AN ACT
2	relating to a limitation on regulations to restrict abortion.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 170, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 170.004 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 170.004. LIMITATION ON ADDITIONAL ABORTION
7	RESTRICTIONS. Notwithstanding any other law, a law enacted on or
8	after June 1, 2013, that restricts access to abortion or the
9	availability of abortion does not take effect unless, not later
10	than September 1, 2014, the executive commissioner of the Health
11	and Human Services Commission finds, and publishes in the Texas
12	Register, that the state has maximized funding for the Texas
13	Women's Health Program with federal funds available through a
14	waiver under Section 1115 of the federal Social Security Act (42
15	<u>U.S.C. Section 1315).</u>
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20	Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
21	legislative session.
