## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to customer protections related to smart thermostat
- 3 services marketing and contracts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 17, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 17.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 17.010. CUSTOMER PROTECTION; SMART THERMOSTATS. (a)
- 8 The commission shall ensure that a retail electric provider or
- 9 aggregator that offers to residential or small commercial customers
- 10 <u>a product or service related to smart thermostats provides to the</u>
- 11 customers in marketing communications and contract materials clear
- 12 descriptions in plain language of the product or service, of the
- 13 contract terms, and of customers' rights.
- 14 (b) The commission shall adopt and enforce rules as
- 15 necessary to implement this section. Rules adopted under this
- 16 <u>section must be at least as protective of customers' interests as</u>
- 17 general commission rules regarding marketing of and contracting for
- 18 electric services for residential and small commercial customers.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 24 legislative session.
