WHEREAS, Mr. Homer was deeply engaged in the civic life of Paris, serving as the director of the Lamar County Chamber of Commerce and the Boys Club of Paris and as a member of the advisory board of St. Joseph's Hospital; he also played a prominent role in the congregation at Our Lady of Victory Catholic Church, and the concern and support he showed for his fellow residents made a
