21 love and affection of his brother, Johnny Martinez, and his sister,

24 determination to contribute to its success, Adrian Martinez has won

1 the admiration of many people, and it is indeed a pleasure to honor  
2 this remarkable young Texan for his achievements; now, therefore,
