1           WHEREAS, Citizens of Irving are coming together to take part  
2 in the annual National Night Out on October 1, 2013; and

3           WHEREAS, Introduced in 1984, National Night Out is sponsored  
4 by the National Association of Town Watch, a nonprofit organization  
5 dedicated to the development and promotion of crime prevention  
6 programs; more than 37 million people in 15,000 communities across  
7 the United States and Canada now participate in the event; and

8           WHEREAS, Commemorated through neighborhood gatherings,  
9 cookouts, parades, flashlight walks, and other activities, the  
10 National Night Out helps to build community cohesiveness,  
11 strengthen relations between residents and local police, and  
12 increase awareness of anticrime strategies, while sending a message  
13 of solidarity to would-be criminals; and

15 overstated, and by taking part in National Night Out observances,  
16 the residents of Irving are affirming their commitment to making  
17 their community stronger and safer; now, therefore, be it
