2 executive director of the North Texas Municipal Water District
3 after 15 years in that post; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Parks began working for the district in 1979 and
5 was promoted to its highest office in 1998; throughout his long and
6 productive tenure, he has demonstrated a sustained commitment to
7 excellence in meeting the needs of the 1.6 million people residing
8 in the 13 area member cities, who rely on the district for
9 high-quality drinking water, waste disposal, and wastewater
10 treatment; and

12 benefited the National Water Resources Association, which he has
13 served as president since 2012, and he currently chairs the Region C
14 Water Planning Group for the Texas Water Development Board; he has

17 American Public Works Association, which in 2005 named him
18 Professional Manager of the Year; and

21 contributions to the field of water resource management and the
22 profession of public works, and he may reflect with satisfaction on
23 all that he has achieved as he embarks on the next exciting chapter
