- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 8, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 8.0532 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 8.0532. PROHIBITION ON SCHOOL DISTRICT USE OF
- 9 CURRICULUM. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 10 <u>subchapter</u>, a school district may not use or authorize its teachers
- 11 or employees to use student curriculum products developed or
- 12 provided before August 31, 2013, by a regional education service
- 13 <u>center acting in collaboration with one or more other regional</u>
- 14 education service centers.

- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 20 legislative session.
