SENATE	JOINT	RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment temporarily increasing the
- 3 rate of the state sales and use tax and dedicating revenue derived

- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 32 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 32. (a) The state sales and use tax imposed on the
- 10 sale, storage, use, or other consumption in this state of a taxable
- 11 <u>item under Chapter 151, Tax Code, or its successor is imposed at a</u>
- 12 rate that is one-half of one percent more than the rates prescribed
- 13 by general law.
- 14 (b) The comptroller of public accounts shall deposit the net
- 15 revenue derived from the state sales and use tax described by
- 16 Subsection (a) of this section at a rate of one-half of one percent
- 17 to the credit of an account in the general revenue fund. Interest
- 18 earned on the account must be credited to the account.
- (c) Revenue deposited in the account under Subsection (b) of
- 20 this section and interest credited to the account may be used only
- 21 to repay the principal of and interest on:
- 22 (1) the following obligations issued on or before
- 23 December 31, 2015:
- 24 (A) obligations issued as authorized by Section

- 1 49-k, Article III, of this constitution;
- 2 (B) bonds and other public securities issued as
- 3 authorized by Section 49-n, Article III, of this constitution, as
- 4 proposed by H.J.R. 28, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, and
- 5 by general law in effect on January 1, 2013; and
- 6 (C) general obligation bonds issued as
- 7 authorized by Section 49-p, Article III, of this constitution; and
- 8 (2) any refunding bonds issued to repay obligations
- 9 described by Subdivision (1).
- 10 (d) This section expires on the earlier of:
- 11 <u>(1) September 1, 2030; or</u>
- 12 (2) the date the principal of and interest on all
- 13 obligations described by Subsection (c) of this section are paid.
- 14 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 15 the Texas Constitution:
- 16 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 17 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 83rd Legislature,
- 18 Regular Session, 2013, temporarily increasing the rate of the state
- 19 sales and use tax and dedicating revenue derived from that rate
- 20 increase to repaying certain transportation bonds and other
- 21 obligations.
- 22 (b) Section 32, Article VIII, of this constitution takes
- 23 effect January 1, 2014.
- 24 <u>(c) This temporary provision expires September 2, 2015.</u>
