WHEREAS, Carmen Gonzalez was married to Rafael Lopez Gonzalez, and the couple was blessed with four children, four grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Gonzalez was one of the first Hispanic women to be named to an upper administration position at the A. Brandt Company factory in the 1940s; she went on to become an administrator at Ben Hogan/AMF, where she was respected for her work and made many close friends; and

WHEREAS, She was a woman of deep compassion and was noted for her devotion to her family and her warm smile; she was an exemplary lady who was a source of strength and joy to others, and she will be greatly missed by all who were privileged to share in her life; now, therefore, be it
