1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1882 (house committee printing) as

- 3 (1) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 4 the bill:
- 5 SECTION . Section 402.009, Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 402.009. AUTHORITY TO EMPLOY AND COMMISSION PEACE
- 8 OFFICERS. (a) The attorney general may employ and commission
- 9 peace officers as investigators for the limited purpose of
- 10 assisting the attorney general in carrying out the duties of
- 11 that office relating to prosecution assistance and crime
- 12 prevention.
- 13 (b) The attorney general shall ensure that an investigator
- 14 employed as authorized under Subsection (a) is compensated
- 15 according to Schedule C of the position classification salary
- schedule prescribed by the General Appropriations Act.
- SECTION ___. Section 659.301(5), Government Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (5) "State employee" means an individual who:
- 20 (A) is a commissioned law enforcement officer of
- 21 the Department of Public Safety, the Texas Facilities
- 22 Commission, the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, $[\frac{or}{c}]$ the
- 23 Texas Department of Criminal Justice, or the attorney general;
- 24 (B) is a commissioned security officer of the
- 25 comptroller;
- 26 (C) is a law enforcement officer commissioned by
- 27 the Parks and Wildlife Commission;
- 28 (D) is a commissioned peace officer of an
- 29 institution of higher education;

- 1 (E) is an employee or official of the Board of
- 2 Pardons and Paroles or the parole division of the Texas
- 3 Department of Criminal Justice if the employee or official has
- 4 routine direct contact with inmates of any penal or correctional
- 5 institution or with administratively released prisoners subject
- 6 to the board's jurisdiction;
- 7 (F) has been certified to the Employees
- 8 Retirement System of Texas under Section 815.505 as having begun
- 9 employment as a law enforcement officer or custodial officer,
- 10 unless the individual has been certified to the system as having
- 11 ceased employment as a law enforcement officer or custodial
- 12 officer; or
- (G) before May 29, 1987, received hazardous duty
- 14 pay based on the terms of any state law if the individual holds
- 15 a position designated under that law as eligible for the pay.
- 16 SECTION . (a) The classification officer in the office
- 17 of the state auditor shall classify the position of commissioned
- 18 peace officer employed as an investigator by the Office of the
- 19 Attorney General as a Schedule C position under the Texas
- 20 Position Classification Plan, 1961.
- 21 (b) The change made by the classification officer as
- 22 required by this section applies beginning in the state fiscal
- 23 biennium beginning September 1, 2013.
- 24 (c) This section expires September 1, 2015.
- 25 (2) Renumber the SECTIONS of the bill appropriately.
