1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 4 (house committee printing) by adding the 2 following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 4 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 16.053(c), Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (c) No later than 60 days after the designation of the 7 regions under Subsection (b), the board shall designate representatives within each regional water planning area to serve 8 as the initial coordinating body for planning. 9 10 coordinating body may then designate additional representatives to 11 serve on the regional water planning group. The initial coordinating body shall designate additional representatives if 12 necessary to ensure adequate representation from the interests 13 14 comprising that region, including the public, municipalities, industries, agricultural interests, environmental 15 16 interests, small businesses, electric generating utilities, river authorities, water districts, and water utilities. The regional 17 18 water planning group shall maintain adequate representation from In addition, the groundwater conservation those interests. 19 districts located in each management area, as defined by Section 20 36.001, located in the regional water planning area shall appoint 21 one representative of a groundwater conservation district located 22 in the management area and in the regional water planning area to 23 serve on the regional water planning group. In addition, the 24 commissioners court of each county located in Regional Water 25 Planning Area D, as the area's boundaries existed on September 1, 26 2013, may appoint one representative of the county to the regional 27 water planning group in that area. In addition, representatives of 28 the board, the Parks and Wildlife Department, and the Department of 29

- 1 Agriculture shall serve as ex officio members of each regional
