| 2 | following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to ARTICLE 1 of the bill |
| 3 | and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the article appropriately: |
| 4 | SECTION 1 Section 39.107, Utilities Code, is amended |
| 5 | by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows: |
| 6 | (k) The commission by rule shall require an electric utility |
| 7 | or transmission and distribution utility to compensate a customer |
| 8 | for damage to the customer's property arising from the |
| 9 | installation, removal, or replacement of an advanced meter or |
| 10 | equipment related to a meter information network. This subsection |
| 11 | does not apply to damage caused by an action of the customer. The |
| 12 | commission may assess civil and administrative penalties under |
| 13 | Section 15.023 against a utility that violates this subsection. |
| 14 | SECTION 1 The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall |
| 15 | adopt rules necessary to implement Section 39.107(k), Utilities |
| 16 | Code, as added by this article, as soon as practicable after the |
| 17 | effective date of this Act. |
