4	SECTION 1 Section 12.053, Utilities Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 12.053. MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS. (a) To be
7	eligible for appointment, a commissioner must [be]:
8	(1) <u>be</u> a qualified voter;
9	(2) <u>be</u> a citizen of the United States; [and]
10	(3) be a competent and experienced administrator;
11	(4) be well informed and qualified in the field of
12	public utilities and utility regulation; and
13	(5) have at least five years of experience in the
14	administration of business or government or as a practicing
15	attorney or certified public accountant [a representative of the
16	general public].
17	(b) Before a person may be appointed as commissioner, the
18	person must submit to the attorney general and the governor's
19	office written disclosure of whether the person, [A person is not
20	eligible for appointment as a commissioner if the person:
21	$[rac{(1)}{1}]$ at any time during the two years preceding
22	appointment:
23	$\underline{(1)}$ [ $\frac{(A)}{(A)}$ ] personally served as an officer, director,
24	owner, employee, partner, or legal representative of a public
25	utility, affiliate, or direct competitor of a public utility; or
26	(2) [ $(B)$ ] owned or controlled, directly or
27	indirectly, stocks or bonds of any class with a value of \$10,000 or
28	more in a public utility, affiliate, or direct competitor of a
29	public utility.

- 2 <u>information</u>.
- 3 (d) A person is not eligible for appointment as a
- 4 commissioner if the person[+ or
- 5  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  is not qualified to serve under Section 12.151,
- 6 12.152, or 12.153.
- 7 SECTION 1.\_\_\_. Section 12.152(a), Utilities Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (a) A person is not eligible for appointment as a
- 10 commissioner or executive director of the commission if:
- 11 (1) the person serves on the board of directors of a
- 12 company that supplies fuel, utility-related services, or
- 13 utility-related products to regulated or unregulated electric or
- 14 telecommunications utilities; or
- 15 (2) the person or the person's spouse:
- 16 (A) is employed by or participates in the
- 17 management of a business entity or other organization that is
- 18 regulated by or receives funds from the commission;
- 19 (B) directly or indirectly owns or controls more
- 20 than a 10 percent interest [or a pecuniary interest with a value
- 21 exceeding \$10,000] in:
- 22 (i) a business entity or other organization
- 23 that is regulated by or receives funds from the commission; or
- 24 (ii) a utility competitor, utility
- 25 supplier, or other entity affected by a commission decision in a
- 26 manner other than by the setting of rates for that class of
- 27 customer;
- 28 (C) uses or receives a substantial amount of
- 29 tangible goods, services, or funds from the commission, other than
- 30 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for commission
- 31 membership, attendance, or expenses; or

- 1 (D) notwithstanding Paragraph (B), has an
- 2 interest in a mutual fund or retirement fund in which more than 10
- 3 percent of the fund's holdings at the time of appointment is in a
- 4 single utility, utility competitor, or utility supplier in this
- 5 state and the person does not disclose this information to the
- 6 governor, senate, commission, or other entity, as appropriate.
- 7 SECTION 1.\_\_\_. Section 12.154(a), Utilities Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (a) During the period of service with the commission, a
- 10 commissioner or commission employee may not:
- 11 (1) have a pecuniary interest, including an interest
- 12 as an officer, director, partner, owner, employee, attorney, or
- 13 consultant, in:
- 14 (A) a public utility or affiliate; or
- 15 (B) a person a significant portion of whose
- 16 business consists of furnishing goods or services to public
- 17 utilities or affiliates; or
- 18 (2) [directly or indirectly own or control securities
- 19 in a public utility, affiliate, or direct competitor of a public
- 20 utility; or
- 21 [<del>(3)</del>] accept a gift, gratuity, or entertainment from:
- 22 (A) a public utility, affiliate, or direct
- 23 competitor of a public utility;
- 24 (B) a person a significant portion of whose
- 25 business consists of furnishing goods or services to public
- 26 utilities, affiliates, or direct competitors of public utilities;
- 27 or
- 28 (C) an agent, representative, attorney,
- 29 employee, officer, owner, director, or partner of a person
- 30 described by Paragraph (A) or (B).
