amended to read as follows:

- 6 (b) If a claim is not made for prize money on or before

- 11 than \$20 million in prize money each year may be deposited to

- 15 from that account to provide indigent health care services as

- 18 may be appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission
- and shall be used to support the provision of inpatient hospital 19

1 (4) all prize money subject to this section and not 2 deposited or appropriated in accordance with [from the Texas Department of Health state-owned multicategorical teaching 3 4 hospital account, not appropriated to the Health and Human 5 Services Commission for the purpose specified in] Subdivision 6 (1), (2), or [and not deposited under Subdivision] (3)[7] shall 7 be deposited to the credit of the foundation school [in the 8 general revenue] fund [and may be appropriated for any purpose 9 as determined by the legislature, including the provision of 10 indigent health care services as specified in Chapter 61, Health 11 and Safety Code]. 12 SECTION . Section 466.408(b), Government Code, 13 amended by this Act, applies only to a prize for which the 14 winner is selected on or after September 1, 2013. A prize for 15 which the winner was selected before September 1, 2013, is 16 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 17 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
