1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 in Article I of the bill, following the  
2 appropriations to the Trusteed Programs Within the Office of the  
3 Governor (page I-55), by adding the following appropriately  
4 numbered rider and renumbering subsequent riders accordingly:

5 \_\_\_\_\_. Report on Driving While Intoxicated. (a) Out of the  
6 amounts appropriated above in Strategy A.1.3, Criminal Justice, the  
7 office of the governor shall conduct a study on driving while  
8 intoxicated, including:

9 (1) monitoring and analyzing data collected in this  
10 state relating to driving fatalities involving intoxicated drivers  
11 and automatic driver's license suspensions for driving while  
12 intoxicated offenses; and

13 (2) monitoring and analyzing the laws and programs of  
14 other states that have been successful in reducing the number of  
15 driving while intoxicated offenses committed in those states.

16 (b) Based on the study conducted under Subsection (a), the  
17 office of the governor shall develop a plan to collaborate with the  
18 Texas Department of Transportation, the Department of Public  
19 Safety, and the Department of State Health Services to reduce  
20 alcoholism and recidivism and the number of driving while  
21 intoxicated offenses committed in this state.

22 (c) Not later than January 1, 2015, the office of the  
23 governor shall submit to the legislature a report of the study  
24 conducted under Subsection (a) and the plan developed under  
25 Subsection (b). The report must:

26 (1) include an evaluation of the efficacy of laws and  
27 programs designed to reduce the number of driving while intoxicated  
28 offenses in this state and in other states; and

29 (2) recommend legislation relating to the prevention

1 of driving while intoxicated in this state.
