1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 in Article II of the bill following  
2 the appropriations to the Department of State Health Services  
3 (page II-74) by amending provision 79:

4 **79. Mental Health Appropriations and the 1115 Medicaid**  
5 **Transformation Waiver.** Out of funds appropriated above in Goal  
6 B., Community Health Services, Strategies B.2.1, Mental Health  
7 Services for Adults, B.2.2, Mental Health Services for Children,  
8 and B.2.3, Community Mental Health Crisis Services, the  
9 Department of State Health Services by contract shall require  
10 that \$172,700,000 in General Revenue funds provided to the  
11 department in this biennium to be used to the extent possible to  
12 draw down additional federal funds through the 1115  
13 transformation waiver or other federal matching  
14 opportunities, and the funds must be used for mental health  
15 services as specified by the department in its performance  
16 contracts. The department shall report to the Legislative  
17 Budget Board and the Governor by December 1, 2014 on efforts to  
18 leverage these funds.

19 In furtherance of the goal to maximize federal matching  
20 opportunity the department and other state agencies are directed  
21 to review and revise the performance agreements, financial and  
22 program reporting requirements or other relevant contracts and

1 agreements with Local Mental Health Authorities as necessary to  
2 facilitate compliance with federal requirements and to allow for  
3 coordination with private hospitals in order to improve access,  
4 availability, delivery, efficiency and funding for behavioral  
5 health services via the 1115 transformation waiver. In  
6 addition, the department will research and address other state  
7 and federal impediments to the implementation of this rider The  
8 department or other state agency shall report to the Legislative  
9 Budget Board and the Governor by December 1, 2014 on efforts  
10 regarding such General Revenue funds.
