Amend C.S. $\frac{1}{2}$.B. No. $\frac{1}{2}$ (house committee printing) by 1 adding the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill 2 and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 SECTION ____. Chapter 42, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 4 amended by adding Article 42.024 to read as follows: 5 Art. 42.024. SENTENCING FOR DRUG POSSESSION OFFENSES. (a) 6 A judge who sentences a defendant convicted of an offense under 7 Section 481.115, 481.1151, 481.116, 481.1161, 481.117, 481.118, or 8 481.121, Health and Safety Code, to a term of confinement in a 9 facility other than a substance abuse felony punishment facility 10 and orders the sentence to be immediately executed shall state on 11 the record and in writing the judge's reasons for requiring 12 confinement in that facility instead of confining the defendant in 13 a substance abuse felony punishment facility, placing the defendant 14 on community supervision, or requiring the defendant to submit to a 15 treatment program, drug court program, or other alternative to 16 confinement and place a copy of the written statement in the papers 17 18 in the case. (b) This section does not apply to a defendant who has 19 previously been convicted of a felony offense involving violence or 20 an offense for which the defendant is required to register as a sex 21 22 offender under Chapter 62. SECTION Subchapter C, Chapter 72, Government Code, is 23 amended by adding Section 72.031 to read as follows: 24 Sec. 72.031. COLLECTION OF DATA REGARDING SENTENCING FOR 25 DRUG POSSESSION OFFENSES. (a) The office annually shall collect 26 data relating to sentencing of persons who are convicted of 27 offenses involving the possession of a controlled substance or 28 marihuana based on copies of written statements made by sentencing

- 2 in the papers in the case.
- 3 (b) Not later than December 1 of each year, the office shall
- 4 publish on its Internet website the data collected under Subsection
- 5 (a) covering the previous state fiscal year.
- 6 SECTION ____. The Office of Court Administration of the
- Texas Judicial System is not required to publish a report under
- 8 Section 72.031, Government Code, as added by this Act, before
- 9 December 1, 2014.
- 10 SECTION _____. Article 42.024, Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 11 as added by this Act, applies to a person convicted of an offense
- 12 involving the possession of a controlled substance or marihuana who
- 13 is sentenced on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless
- 14 of whether the offense is committed before, on, or after the
- 15 effective date of this Act.
