1	Amend C.S.S.B. No. 215 (house committee report) by adding the
2	following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and
3	renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
4	SECTION Subchapter C, Chapter 62, Education Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER C. TEXAS COMPETITIVE KNOWLEDGE [RESEARCH UNIVERSITY
7	DEVELOPMENT] FUND
8	Sec. 62.051. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Eligible institution" means an institution of
10	higher education that:
11	(A) is designated as a research university [or
12	emerging research university] under the coordinating board's
13	accountability system and, for any three consecutive state fiscal
14	years beginning on or after September 1, 2010, made total annual
15	research expenditures in an average annual amount of not less than
16	\$450 million; or
17	(B) is designated as an emerging research
18	university under the coordinating board's accountability system
19	and, for any three consecutive state fiscal years beginning on or
20	after September 1, 2010, made total annual research expenditures in
21	an average annual amount of not less than \$50 million.
22	(2) "Fund" means the Texas competitive knowledge fund.
23	(3) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
24	assigned by Section 61.003.
25	Sec. 62.052. PURPOSE. The purpose of this subchapter is to
26	provide funding to eligible research universities and emerging
27	research universities to support faculty to ensure excellence in
28	instruction and research [for the recruitment and retention of
29	highly qualified faculty and the enhancement of research

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productivity at those universities].
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- 2 Sec. 62.053. FUND [FUNDING]. (a) The Texas competitive knowledge fund consists of money [For each state fiscal year, the 3 coordinating board shall distribute any funds] appropriated by the 5 legislature for the purposes of this subchapter[7 and any other funds made available for the purposes of this subchapter, of eligible institutions [based on the average amount of total 7 research funds expended by each institution annually during the three most recent state fiscal years, according to the following 10 rates:
- [(1) at least \$1 million for every \$10 million of the
 average annual amount of those research funds expended by the
 institution, if that average amount for the institution is \$50
 million or more; and
- [(2) at least \$500,000 for every \$10 million of the
 average annual amount of those research funds expended by the
 institution, if that average amount for the institution is less
 than \$50 million].
- 19 For purposes of this section [Subsection (a)], the (b) 20 amount of total research funds expended by an eligible institution in a state fiscal year is the amount of those funds as reported to 21 22 the coordinating board by the institution for that fiscal year, 23 subject to any adjustment by the coordinating board in accordance with the standards and accounting methods the coordinating board 24 prescribes for purposes of this section. [If the funds available 25 for distribution for a state fiscal year under Subsection (a) are 26 not sufficient to provide the amount specified by Subsection (a) 27 for each eligible institution or exceed the amount sufficient for 28 29 that purpose, the available amount shall be distributed in proportion to the total amount to which each institution is 30

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otherwise entitled under Subsection (a).]

Sec. 62.0535. INITIAL CONTRIBUTION. For the first state 1 fiscal biennium in which an eligible institution receives an 2 appropriation under this subchapter, the institution's other general revenue appropriations shall be reduced by an amount not to exceed the lesser of \$5 million for the biennium or the amount of 5 the institution's appropriation under this subchapter for the 6 biennium. The bill making the appropriation must expressly 7 identify the purpose for which the appropriations were reduced in 8 accordance with this section. 9 Sec. 62.054. APPROPRIATION AMOUNTS [RULES]. 10 11

(a) Of the total amount appropriated for purposes of this subchapter in a state fiscal year, an eligible institution is entitled to receive 12 an appropriation in the amount determined in accordance with this 13 14 section.

(b) Not less than 50 percent of the total amount appropriated for purposes of this subchapter shall be appropriated to eligible institutions described by Section 62.051(1)(A). Each 17 institution is entitled to receive a share of that amount in 18 proportion to the average amount of total research funds expended 19 by each institution annually during the three fiscal years 20 preceding the state fiscal biennium for which the money is 21 appropriated. 22

(c) The remainder of the total amount appropriated for purposes of this subchapter shall be appropriated to eligible institutions described by Section 62.051(1)(B). Each institution is entitled to receive a share of that amount in proportion to the average amount of total research funds expended by each institution annually during the three fiscal years preceding the state fiscal biennium for which the money is appropriated. [The coordinating 29 board shall adopt rules for the administration of this subchapter, 30 including any rules the coordinating board considers necessary 31

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- 1 regarding the submission to the coordinating board by eligible
- 2 institutions of any student data required for the coordinating
- 3 board to carry out its duties under this subchapter.
