

FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. _____

1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 219 (house committee report) by adding the
2 following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to ARTICLE 4 of the bill
3 and renumbering remaining SECTIONS of that ARTICLE accordingly:

4 SECTION 4.____. Section 251.001, Election Code, is amended
5 by adding Subdivision (21) to read as follows:

6 (21) "In-kind contribution" means a contribution of
7 goods, services, or any other thing of value, except money.

8 SECTION 4.____. Subsection (a), Section 254.031, Election
9 Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, each
11 report filed under this chapter must include:

12 (1) the amount of political contributions, not
13 including in-kind contributions, from each person that in the
14 aggregate exceed \$50 and that are accepted during the reporting
15 period by the person or committee required to file a report under
16 this chapter, the full name and address of the person making the
17 contributions, and the dates of the contributions;

18 (2) the amount of loans that are made during the
19 reporting period for campaign or officeholder purposes to the
20 person or committee required to file the report and that in the
21 aggregate exceed \$50, the dates the loans are made, the interest
22 rate, the maturity date, the type of collateral for the loans, if
23 any, the full name and address of the person or financial
24 institution making the loans, the full name and address, principal
25 occupation, and name of the employer of each guarantor of the loans,
26 the amount of the loans guaranteed by each guarantor, and the
27 aggregate principal amount of all outstanding loans as of the last
28 day of the reporting period;

29 (3) the amount of political expenditures that in the

1 aggregate exceed \$100 and that are made during the reporting
2 period, the full name and address of the persons to whom the
3 expenditures are made, and the dates and purposes of the
4 expenditures;

5 (4) the amount of each payment made during the
6 reporting period from a political contribution if the payment is
7 not a political expenditure, the full name and address of the person
8 to whom the payment is made, and the date and purpose of the
9 payment;

10 (5) the total amount or a specific listing of the
11 political contributions, not including in-kind contributions, of
12 \$50 or less accepted and the total amount or a specific listing of
13 the political expenditures of \$100 or less made during the
14 reporting period;

15 (6) the total amount of all political contributions,
16 not including in-kind contributions, accepted and the total amount
17 of all political expenditures made during the reporting period;

18 (7) the name of each candidate or officeholder who
19 benefits from a direct campaign expenditure made during the
20 reporting period by the person or committee required to file the
21 report, and the office sought or held, excluding a direct campaign
22 expenditure that is made by the principal political committee of a
23 political party on behalf of a slate of two or more nominees of that
24 party;

25 (8) as of the last day of a reporting period for which
26 the person is required to file a report, the total amount of
27 political contributions accepted, including interest or other
28 income on those contributions, maintained in one or more accounts
29 in which political contributions are deposited as of the last day of
30 the reporting period;

31 (9) any credit, interest, rebate, refund,

1 reimbursement, or return of a deposit fee resulting from the use of
2 a political contribution or an asset purchased with a political
3 contribution that is received during the reporting period and the
4 amount of which exceeds \$100;

5 (10) any proceeds of the sale of an asset purchased
6 with a political contribution that is received during the reporting
7 period and the amount of which exceeds \$100;

8 (11) any investment purchased with a political
9 contribution that is received during the reporting period and the
10 amount of which exceeds \$100;

11 (12) any other gain from a political contribution that
12 is received during the reporting period and the amount of which
13 exceeds \$100; ~~and~~

14 (13) the full name and address of each person from whom
15 an amount described by Subdivision (9), (10), (11), or (12) is
16 received, the date the amount is received, and the purpose for which
17 the amount is received; and

18 (14) on a separate schedule:

19 (A) the amount of in-kind political
20 contributions from each person that in the aggregate exceed \$50 and
21 that are used or expended during the reporting period and the date
22 and purpose of such use or expenditure; and

23 (B) the total amount of all in-kind contributions
24 accepted during the reporting period.
