- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 551.1281 to read as follows:
- Sec. 551.1281. GOVERNING BOARD OF GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING 8
- INSTITUTION OR UNIVERSITY SYSTEM: INTERNET POSTING OF MEETING 9
- MATERIALS AND BROADCAST OF OPEN MEETING. (a) In this section, 10
- "general academic teaching institution" and "university system" 11
- have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code. 12
- (b) The governing board of a general academic teaching 13
- 14 institution or of a university system that includes one or more
- component general academic teaching institutions, for any 15
- 16 regularly scheduled meeting of the governing board for which notice
- is required under this chapter, shall: 17
- 18 (1) post as early as practicable in advance of the
- meeting on the Internet website of the institution or university 19
- system, as applicable, any written agenda and related supplemental 20
- written materials provided by the institution or system to the 21
- governing board members for the members' use during the meeting; 22
- 23 (2) broadcast the meeting, other than any portions of
- 24 the meeting closed to the public as authorized by law, over the

- 1 Internet in the manner prescribed by Section 551.128; and
- 2 (3) record the broadcast and make that recording
- 3 publicly available in an online archive located on the
- 4 institution's or university system's Internet website.
- 5 (c) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to written materials
- 6 that the general counsel or other appropriate attorney for the
- 7 institution or university system certifies are confidential or may
- 8 be withheld from public disclosure under Chapter 552.
- 9 (d) The governing board of a general academic teaching
- 10 institution or of a university system is not required to comply with
- 11 the requirements of this section if that compliance is not possible
- 12 because of an act of God, force majeure, or a similar cause not
- 13 reasonably within the governing board's control.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a meeting of the governing board of a general academic teaching
- 16 institution or of a state university system for which notice is
- 17 given under Chapter 551, Government Code, on or after January 1,
- 18 2014.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
