4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 551.1281 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 551.1281. GOVERNING BOARD OF GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING
8	INSTITUTION OR UNIVERSITY SYSTEM: INTERNET POSTING OF MEETING
9	MATERIALS AND BROADCAST OF OPEN MEETING. (a) In this section,
10	"general academic teaching institution" and "university system'
11	have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
12	(b) The governing board of a general academic teaching
13	institution or of a university system that includes one or more
14	component general academic teaching institutions, for any
15	regularly scheduled meeting of the governing board for which notice
16	is required under this chapter, shall:
17	(1) post as early as practicable in advance of the
18	meeting on the Internet website of the institution or university
19	system, as applicable, any written agenda and related supplemental
20	written materials provided by the institution or system to the
21	board members for the members' use during the meeting; and
22	(2) broadcast the meeting, other than any portions of
23	the meeting closed to the public as authorized by law, over the

Internet in the manner prescribed by Section 551.128.

- 1 (c) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to written materials
- 2 that the general counsel or other appropriate attorney for the
- 3 institution or university system certifies are confidential or may
- 4 be withheld from public disclosure under Chapter 552.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to a meeting of the governing board of a state university or of a
- 7 state university system for which notice is given under Chapter
- 8 551, Government Code, on or after January 1, 2014.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
