Section 550.021(c), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (C) A person commits an offense if the person does not stop or does not comply with the requirements of this section. 8 An offense under this section: 9 involving an accident resulting in: 10 (1)11 death of a person is a felony of the second (A) 12 degree; or serious bodily injury, as defined by Section 13 (B) 14 1.07, Penal Code, to a person is a felony of the third degree; and involving an accident resulting in injury to which 15 (2) 16 Subdivision (1) does not apply is punishable by: imprisonment in the Texas Department 17 (A) of 18 Criminal Justice for not more than five years or confinement in the county jail for not more than one year; 19 20 (B) a fine not to exceed \$5,000; or 21 (C) both the fine and the imprisonment or 22 confinement. 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 24

1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 4 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 6 before that date.
