- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.038 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.038. ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT REVIEW; REPORTING. (a)
- 8 To ensure the validity and reliability of an assessment instrument
- 9 administered under Section 39.023, the agency shall evaluate the
- 10 assessment instrument:
- 11 (1) before the assessment instrument is first
- 12 administered; and
- 13 (2) periodically during the period the assessment
- 14 instrument is administered.
- 15 (b) The commissioner by rule shall adopt, for purposes of
- 16 this section, standards for the validity and reliability of
- 17 assessment instruments administered under Section 39.023 and
- 18 procedures to conduct evaluations of those assessment instruments.
- 19 <u>(c) The agency shall post on the agency's Internet website</u>
- 20 the results of evaluations conducted under this section.
- 21 (d) The commissioner shall adopt rules to administer this
- 22 section.
- SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2014, the commissioner

- 2 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 39.038(a)(1), Education
- 3 Code, as added by this Act, if an assessment instrument
- 4 administered under Section 39.023, Education Code, was first
- 5 administered before the 2014-2015 school year, the Texas Education
- 6 Agency shall evaluate the assessment instrument as provided by
- 7 Section 39.038, Education Code, as added by this Act, before
- 8 September 1, 2014.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 39.038(a), Education Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, applies to administration of assessment instruments under
- 11 Section 39.023, Education Code, beginning with the 2014-2015 school
- 12 year.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
