- 2 relating to surcharges associated with and the enforcement of the

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 708.002, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 708.002. RULES. The department shall adopt [and
- 8 enforce] rules to implement [and enforce] this chapter.
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 708.151(a) and (c), Transportation
- 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The department shall send notices as required by
- 12 Subsection (b) to the holder of a driver's license when a surcharge
- 13 is assessed on that license. Each notice must:
- 14 (1) be sent by first class mail to the person's most
- 15 recent address as shown on the records of the department or to the
- 16 person's most recent forwarding address on record with the United
- 17 States Postal Service if it is different;
- 18 (2) specify the date by which the surcharge must be
- 19 paid; <u>and</u>
- 20 (3) state the total dollar amount of the surcharge
- 21 that must be paid, the number of monthly payments required under an
- 22 installment payment plan, and the minimum monthly payment required
- 23 for a person to enter and maintain an installment payment plan with
- 24 the department [; and

- 1 [(4) state the consequences of a failure to pay the
- 2 surcharge].
- 3 (c) If on or before the 45th day after the date the first
- 4 notice was sent the person fails to pay the amount of the surcharge
- 5 or fails to enter into an installment payment agreement with the
- 6 department, the department shall send a second notice. If on or
- 7 before the 60th day after the date the second notice was sent the
- 8 person fails to pay the amount of the surcharge or fails to enter
- 9 into an installment payment agreement with the department, the
- 10 department shall send a third notice [that advises the person that
- 11 the person's driving privileges are suspended].
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 708.152, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 708.152. FAILURE TO PAY SURCHARGE. The department may
- 15 not impose a penalty on a person who fails to pay the amount of a
- 16 <u>surcharge on the person's license.</u> [(a) If on the 60th day after
- 17 the date the department sends a second notice under Section 708.151
- 18 the person fails to pay the amount of a surcharge on the person's
- 19 license or fails to enter into an installment payment agreement
- 20 with the department, the license of the person is automatically
- 21 suspended. A person's license may not be suspended under this
- 22 section before the 105th day after the date the surcharge was
- 23 assessed by the department.
- 24 [(b) A license suspended under this section remains
- 25 suspended until the person pays the amount of the surcharge and any
- 26 related costs.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 708, Transportation Code,

C.S.H.B. No. 104

- 1 is amended by adding Section 708.160 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 708.160. MORATORIUM ON COLLECTION OF SURCHARGES. (a)
- 3 Except as provided by Subsection (b), the department may not
- 4 collect a surcharge described by this chapter on or after September
- 5 1, 2013.
- 6 (b) The department may collect a surcharge described by this
- 7 chapter on or after September 1, 2015, unless another source of
- 8 revenue is dedicated to the designated trauma facility and
- 9 emergency medical services account established under Section
- 10 780.003, Health and Safety Code, that:
- 11 (1) is roughly equal to the amount of revenue
- 12 <u>dedicated to the account under this chapter; and</u>
- (2) was dedicated to the account on or after January 1,
- 14 2013.
- SECTION 5. Sections 708.154(b) and (c), Transportation
- 16 Code, are repealed.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
