2	relating to the fees collected by prosecutors for collection and
3	processing of certain checks or similar sight orders.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 102.007(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	(c) The amount of the fee may not exceed:
8	(1) $\frac{\$20}{\$20}$ [ $\frac{\$10}{\$10}$ ] if the face amount of the check or sight
9	order does not exceed \$10;
10	(2) $\frac{\$30}{\$30}$ [ $\$15$ ] if the face amount of the check or sight
11	order is greater than \$10 but does not exceed \$100;
12	(3) $\frac{\$55}{\$50}$ [ $\frac{\$30}{\$30}$ ] if the face amount of the check or sight
13	order is greater than \$100 but does not exceed \$300;
14	(4) $\frac{\$100}{\$50}$ if the face amount of the check or sight
15	order is greater than \$300 but does not exceed \$500; [ <del>and</del> ]
16	(5) $\frac{\$150}{\$75}$ if the face amount of the check or sight
17	order is greater than \$500 <u>but does not exceed \$1,000;</u>
18	(6) \$350 if the face amount of the check or sight order
19	is greater than \$1,000 but does not exceed \$5,000;
20	(7) \$475 if the face amount of the check or sight order
21	is greater than \$5,000 but does not exceed \$10,000;
22	(8) \$675 if the face amount of the check or sight order
23	is greater than \$10,000 but does not exceed \$30,000;
24	(9) \$800 if the face amount of the check or sight order

## 1 is greater than \$30,000 but does not exceed \$50,000; and

2 (10) \$1,000 if the face amount of the check or sight
3 order is greater than \$50,000.

4 SECTION 2. Section 103.021, Government Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 103.021. ADDITIONAL FEES AND COSTS IN CRIMINAL OR 7 CIVIL CASES: CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE. An accused or defendant, 8 or a party to a civil suit, as applicable, shall pay the following 9 fees and costs under the Code of Criminal Procedure if ordered by 10 the court or otherwise required:

(1) a personal bond fee (Art. 17.42, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . the greater of \$20 or three percent of the amount of the bail fixed for the accused;

2 (4) repayment of reward paid by a crime stoppers
3 organization on conviction of a felony (Art. 37.073, Code of
4 Criminal Procedure) . . . amount ordered;

5 (5) reimbursement to general revenue fund for payments 6 made to victim of an offense as condition of community supervision 7 (Art. 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$50 for 8 a misdemeanor offense or \$100 for a felony offense;

9 (6) payment to a crime stoppers organization as 10 condition of community supervision (Art. 42.12, Code of Criminal 11 Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$50;

12 (7) children's advocacy center fee (Art. 42.12, Code
13 of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$50;

14 (8) family violence center fee (Art. 42.12, Code of
15 Criminal Procedure) . . \$100;

16 (9) community supervision fee (Art. 42.12, Code of 17 Criminal Procedure) . . . not less than \$25 or more than \$60 per 18 month;

(10) additional community supervision fee for certain offenses (Art. 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . \$5 per month;

(11) for certain financially able sex offenders as a condition of community supervision, the costs of treatment, specialized supervision, or rehabilitation (Art. 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . all or part of the reasonable and necessary costs of the treatment, supervision, or rehabilitation as determined by the judge;

(12) fee for failure to appear for trial in a justice
 or municipal court if a jury trial is not waived (Art. 45.026, Code
 of Criminal Procedure) . . . costs incurred for impaneling the
 jury;

5 (13) costs of certain testing, assessments, or 6 programs during a deferral period (Art. 45.051, Code of Criminal 7 Procedure)...amount ordered;

8 (14) special expense on dismissal of certain 9 misdemeanor complaints (Art. 45.051, Code of Criminal Procedure) 10 . . . not to exceed amount of fine assessed;

(15) an additional fee:

(A) for a copy of the defendant's driving record to be requested from the Department of Public Safety by the judge (Art. 45.0511(c-1), Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . amount equal to the sum of the fee established by Section 521.048, Transportation Code, and the state electronic Internet portal fee;

(B) as an administrative fee for requesting a driving safety course or a course under the motorcycle operator training and safety program for certain traffic offenses to cover the cost of administering the article (Art. 45.0511(f)(1), Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$10; or

(C) for requesting a driving safety course or a course under the motorcycle operator training and safety program before the final disposition of the case (Art. 45.0511(f)(2), Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed the maximum amount of the fine for the offense committed by the defendant;

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4 (17) a fee to cover costs of required duties of teen

6 court ordering the fee is located in the Texas-Louisiana border
7 region, but otherwise \$10;

8 (18) a mileage fee for officer performing certain 9 services (Art. 102.001, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . \$0.15 per 10 mile;

(19) certified mailing of notice of hearing date (Art.
12 102.006, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . \$1, plus postage;

13 (20) certified mailing of certified copies of an order 14 of expunction (Art. 102.006, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . \$2, 15 plus postage;

16 (20-a) a fee to defray the cost of notifying state 17 agencies of orders of expungement (Art. 45.0216, Code of Criminal 18 Procedure) . . . \$30 per application;

19 (20-b) a fee to defray the cost of notifying state 20 agencies of orders of expunction (Art. 45.055, Code of Criminal 21 Procedure) . . . \$30 per application;

(A) if the face amount of the check or sight order
does not exceed \$10 (Art. 102.007, Code of Criminal Procedure)
. . not to exceed <u>\$20</u> [<del>\$10</del>];

(B) if the face amount of the check or sight order
is greater than \$10 but does not exceed \$100 (Art. 102.007, Code of

1 Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed <u>\$30</u> [<del>\$15</del>]; (C) if the face amount of the check or sight order 2 3 is greater than \$100 but does not exceed \$300 (Art. 102.007, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$55 [\$30]; 4 5 (D) if the face amount of the check or sight order is greater than \$300 but does not exceed \$500 (Art. 102.007, Code of 6 Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$100 [\$50]; [and] 7 8 (E) if the face amount of the check or sight order is greater than \$500 but does not exceed \$1,000 (Art. 102.007, Code 9 10 of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed <u>\$150</u> [<del>\$75</del>]; 11 (F) if the face amount of the check or sight order 12 is greater than \$1,000 but does not exceed \$5,000 (Art. 102.007, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$350; 13 14 (G) if the face amount of the check or sight order 15 is greater than \$5,000 but does not exceed \$10,000 (Art. 102.007, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$475; 16 17 (H) if the face amount of the check or sight order is greater than \$10,000 but does not exceed \$30,000 (Art. 102.007, 18 Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$675; 19 (I) if the face amount of the check or sight order 20 is greater than \$30,000 but does not exceed \$50,000 (Art. 102.007, 21 Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$800; and 22 23 (J) if the face amount of the check or sight order is greater than \$50,000 (Art. 102.007, Code of Criminal Procedure) 24 25 . . . not to exceed \$1,000; 26 (22) fees for a pretrial intervention program: (A) a supervision fee (Art. 102.012(a), Code of 27

1 Criminal Procedure) . . . \$60 a month plus expenses; and (B) district attorney, criminal 2 а district 3 attorney, or county attorney administrative fee (Art. 102.0121, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$500; 4 5 (23) parking fee violations for child safety fund in municipalities with populations: 6 greater than 850,000 (Art. 102.014, Code of 7 (A) Criminal Procedure) . . . not less than \$2 and not to exceed \$5; and 8 9 less than 850,000 (Art. 102.014, Code of (B) Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$5; 10 (24) an administrative fee for collection of fines, 11 12 fees, restitution, or other costs (Art. 102.072, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . not to exceed \$2 for each transaction; and 13 14 (25) а collection fee, if authorized by the commissioners court of a county or the governing body of a 15 municipality, for certain debts and accounts receivable, including 16 17 unpaid fines, fees, court costs, forfeited bonds, and restitution

18 ordered paid (Art. 103.0031, Code of Criminal Procedure) . . . 30 19 percent of an amount more than 60 days past due.

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a check or sight order issued or passed on or after the effective date of this Act. A check or sight order issued or passed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect at the time of issuance or passing of the check or sight order, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
