SECTION 4. Sections 31.033(a) and (b), Parks and Wildife Code, are amended to read as follows:
(a) No person may paint, attach, or otherwise display on the forward half [either side of the bow] of a vessel a number other than the number awarded to the vessel or granted reciprocity under this chapter.
(b) No person may deface or alter the certificate of number or the number assigned to and appearing on [thebow] a vessel. SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
