- 4 SECTION 1. Section 504.202(e-1), Transportation Code, is

- 7 (h), license plates issued under this section to a person also
- 8 entitled to license plates issued under Section 504.308, 504.315,
- 9 [or] 504.316, or 504.319 may, at the request of the person, include

- 11 entitled.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 504.301, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 14 (c) Section 504.702 does not apply to a specialty license
- 15 plate issued under this subchapter.
- SECTION 3. Section 504.315(a), Transportation Code, as
- 17 added by Chapter 709 (H.B. 559), Acts of the 82nd Legislature,
- 18 Regular Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The department shall issue specialty license plates for
- 20 recipients of the Bronze Star Medal and Bronze Star Medal with
- 21 Valor. License plates issued under this subsection must include
- 22 the Bronze Star Medal emblem and must include the words "Bronze Star

- 4 SECTION 4. Section 504.315(a), Transportation Code, as
- 5 added by Chapter 460 (S.B. 1755), Acts of the 82nd Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 2011, is redesignated as Section 504.315(b),
- 7 Transportation Code, and amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) $[\frac{a}{a}]$ The department shall issue specialty license
- 9 plates for recipients of the Distinguished Service Medal. License
- 10 plates issued under this subsection must include the Distinguished
- 11 Service Medal emblem and the words "Distinguished Service Medal" at
- 12 the bottom of each plate. [Section 504.702 does not apply to
- 13 license plates authorized by this subsection.
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 504.315(h), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (h) The department shall issue special license plates for
- 17 recipients of the Silver Star Medal. License plates issued under
- 18 this subsection must include the Silver Star Medal emblem and must
- 19 include the words "Silver Star Medal" at the bottom of each
- 20 plate. [Section 504.702 does not apply to license plates

- SECTION 6. Subchapter D, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 23 is amended by adding Section 504.319 to read as follows:
- Sec. 504.319. DEFENSE SUPERIOR SERVICE MEDAL RECIPIENTS.
- 25 The department shall issue specialty license plates for recipients
- 26 of the Defense Superior Service Medal. License plates issued under
- 27 this section must include the words "Defense Superior Service

- 1 Medal" at the bottom of each plate.
- 2 SECTION 7. Section 681.008(b), Transportation Code, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) A vehicle on which license plates described by
- 5 Subsection (a)(2) or issued under Section 504.202, 504.315,
- 6 [Section 504.315(a), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), or (h), or Section]
- 7 504.316, or 504.319 are displayed is exempt from the payment of a
- 8 parking fee collected through a parking meter charged by a
- 9 governmental authority other than a branch of the federal
- 10 government, when being operated by or for the transportation of:
- 11 (1) the person who registered the vehicle under
- 12 Section 504.202(a), 504.315, [Section 504.315(a), (c), (d), (e),
- 13 (f), (g), or (h), or Section] 504.316, or 504.319;
- 14 (2) a person described in Section 504.202(b) if the
- 15 vehicle is registered under that subsection; or
- 16 (3) the owner or operator of a vehicle displaying
- 17 license plates described by Subsection (a)(2).
- 18 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
