## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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2 relating to the exercise of urban renewal powers by certain 3 counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 374.902(b), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b) A county with a population of more than 65,000 and less than 300,000 and located along an international border or a county 8 9 with a population of more than 1.3 million may exercise the powers provided for municipalities under this chapter with respect to 10 11 areas of the county that are not within the corporate boundaries of 12 a municipality or areas of the county located within the corporate boundaries of a municipality, if the municipality approves the 13 14 county's participation in an urban renewal project through an interlocal agreement under Chapter 791, Government Code. 15 The 16 county may not exercise those powers until the commissioners court of the county adopts a resolution in the manner provided by Section 17 374.011 for adoption of a resolution by a municipality. 18 The resolution must be approved at an election held in the county in the 19 20 manner provided for a municipal election under Section 374.011. 21 The adoption of the resolution is not approved unless a majority of the voters who vote on the question in the entire county as well as 22 23 in each municipality in the county approve the adoption of the resolution. In a municipality that is only partially located in the 24

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1 affected county, only voters who reside in the county may vote.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
