A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the identification information required of an applicant 3 for a driver's license.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 7 follows:

An application for an original license must state the 8 (a) 9 applicant's full name and place and date of birth. This information must be verified by presentation of proof of identity satisfactory 10 to the department. An applicant who is not a citizen of the United 11 12 States must present to the department documentation issued by the appropriate United States agency that authorizes the applicant to 13 14 be in the United States before the applicant may be issued a driver's license. The department must accept the following 15 16 documents as satisfactory proof of identity under this subsection:

17 (1) an offender identification card or similar form of 18 identification issued to an inmate by the Texas Department of 19 Criminal Justice if the applicant also provides supplemental 20 verifiable records or documents that aid in establishing identity; 21 or

22 (2) an identity document that is issued by the 23 government of another country, if that document bears the 24 applicant's photograph, full name, and date of birth and the
