	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to a driver's license renewal appointment system for
3	prospective anatomical gift donors.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 521.276 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 521.276. DRIVER'S LICENSE RENEWAL APPOINTMENT SYSTEM
8	FOR PROSPECTIVE ANATOMICAL GIFT DONORS. (a) The department shall
9	establish a system to allow a prospective anatomical gift donor to
10	make an appointment for the person's driver's license renewal.
11	Under the system:
12	(1) an appointment may be made not later than 24 hours
13	before the time scheduled for the appointment;
14	(2) the department must make available at least four
15	appointment times during each hour that the department office is
16	open to the public for license renewal; and
17	(3) the department may refuse to renew the license at
18	the appointment if the person does not consent to inclusion in the
19	donor registry.
20	(b) The department shall include information about the
21	availability of appointments for a prospective anatomical gift
22	donor in license renewal notices.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
