1 AN ACT 2 relating to the applicability of adverse licensing, listing, or 3 registration decisions by certain health and human services agencies. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 531.951(a), Government Code, as added by Chapter 1051 (S.B. 78), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular 7 Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows: 8 This subchapter applies only to the final licensing, 9 (a) listing, or registration decisions of a health and human services 10 agency with respect to a person under the law authorizing the agency 11 12 to regulate the following types of persons: 13 (1) a youth camp licensed under Chapter 141, Health 14 and Safety Code; (2) a home and community support services agency 15 licensed under Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code; 16 a hospital licensed under Chapter 241, Health and 17 (3) Safety Code; 18 (4) an institution licensed under Chapter 242, Health 19 20 and Safety Code; 21 (4-a) an abortion facility licensed under Chapter 245, 22 Health and Safety Code; (5) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter 23 24 247, Health and Safety Code;

No. 159 1 (6) a special care facility licensed under Chapter 2 248, Health and Safety Code; 3 (7) an intermediate care facility licensed under 4 Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code; (8) a chemical dependency treatment facility licensed 5 6 under Chapter 464, Health and Safety Code; 7 a mental hospital or mental health facility (9) licensed under Chapter 577, Health and Safety Code; 8 (10) a child-care facility or child-placing agency 9 licensed under or a family home listed or registered under Chapter 10 42, Human Resources Code; or 11 (11)an adult day-care facility licensed under Chapter 12 103, Human Resources Code. 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 14
