- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 662.056 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 662.056. AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE DAY. (a) The last
- 7 Friday in September is American Indian Heritage Day in recognition
- 8 of the historic, cultural, and social contributions American Indian
- 9 communities and leaders have made to this state.
- 10 (b) American Indian Heritage Day shall be regularly
- 11 observed by appropriate ceremonies, activities, and programs in the
- 12 public schools and other places to honor American Indians in this
- 13 state and to celebrate the rich traditional and contemporary
- 14 American Indian culture.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
