14	(3) fluid milk substitutions permitted by the United
15	States Department of Agriculture under 7 C.F.R. Section 210.10;
16	(4) 100 percent vegetable juice; or
17	(5) 100 percent fruit juice.
18	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply:
19	(1) on a day that school is not in session;
20	(2) before the beginning of the breakfast period; or
21	(3) after the end of the last instruction period of the

1 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a contract entered into 2 or renewed between a school district and a vendor on or after the 3 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into or renewed 4 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 5 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that 6 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
