- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 36.06(a) and (b), Penal Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if he intentionally or
- 8 knowingly harms or threatens to harm another by an unlawful act:
- 9 (1) in retaliation for or on account of the service or
- 10 status of another as a:
- 11 (A) public servant, process server, witness,
- 12 prospective witness, or informant; or
- 13 (B) person who has reported or who the actor
- 14 knows intends to report the occurrence of a crime; or
- 15 (2) to prevent or delay the service of another as a:
- 16 (A) public servant, process server, witness,
- 17 prospective witness, or informant; or
- 18 (B) person who has reported or who the actor
- 19 knows intends to report the occurrence of a crime.
- 20 (b) In this section:
- 21 (1) "Civil process" means all process issued or
- 22 <u>sanctioned by a civil court.</u>
- 23 (2) "Honorably retired peace officer" means a peace
- 24 officer who:

- 1 (A) did not retire in lieu of any disciplinary
- 2 action;
- 3 (B) was eligible to retire from a law enforcement
- 4 agency or was ineligible to retire only as a result of an injury
- 5 received in the course of the officer's employment with the agency;
- 6 and
- 7 (C) is entitled to receive a pension or annuity
- 8 for service as a law enforcement officer or is not entitled to
- 9 receive a pension or annuity only because the law enforcement
- 10 agency that employed the officer does not offer a pension or annuity
- 11 to its employees.
- 12 (3) $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ "Informant" means a person who has
- 13 communicated information to the government in connection with any
- 14 governmental function.
- 15 (4) "Process server" means a person who serves civil
- 16 process.
- 17 (5) [(3)] "Public servant" includes an honorably
- 18 retired peace officer.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
